

Weighing Guidance

The requirements for weighing and the weight ticket detail are quite strict and, to avoid having to redo the weighing, you should ensure that you check your weight ticket has all the required information shown.

It is also recommended that, where possible, you use a smartphone, or similar device, to record the vehicle being weighed.

- Your vehicle should be weighed unladen/empty unless specially fit with any fixed equipment.
- You **should not** weigh the vehicle with either a driver or passenger sat in the vehicle.
- For chassis cabs with a body (not a panel van), you should ensure that the vehicle is weighed with the body attached. Please see list of vehicle types not suitable for downrating to 3500kg. Sorry this is a DVSA rule and we cannot consider these types regardless of unladen weight.
- Make sure your weight ticket shows :
 - the registration number of your vehicle
 - the company name and address of the weighing station
 - the unladen weight is printed and not hand written. If the weighing station are unable to print the weight, please ensure video footage is available of the vehicle on the weighbridge and of the weighing system within one recording.
 - Check that the recorded weight is within the DVSA guidelines for vehicle category.
 - Chassis with body – 2250kg or less
 - Panel Vans (not lutons) – 2500kg or less

The below photos show weight tickets that are not acceptable and one that is correct. Please check your ticket is correct before submitting this through to us, as missing details will be rejected by DVSA.

Check the ticket twice, weigh the vehicle once 😊



Example 3 – Only acceptable when supported with video, as details are hand written.

We would raise a query over the unladen weight being exactly 2500kg, though for a chassis with body attached this unladen weight exceeds 2250kg and would not meet with the DVSA requirements.

Example 4 – Correct ticket, should be acceptable subject to the intended use.

Weight 20kg over 2250kg guide weight, so more interest would be paid to the usage of the vehicle, to ensure a risk of overloading wasn't likely.
